The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.1.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 1770 of 2016. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition, at this stage, is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the legal notice (Annexure P-5) and shall pass an appropriate speaking order within a period of three months in accordance with law.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 5.10.2018 was filed annexing order dated 14.7.2016 and payment report dated 20.8.2018.

Perusal of order dated 14.7.2016 shows that the claim of the petitioner in the legal notice has been partly accepted vide order, f/amily

pension has been re-fixed and the claim with regard to interest has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that arrears of pension have been paid on 25.1.2018 as per bank statement attached.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner in spite of two pass-overs.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
