Writ petition filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to the respondents to provide proper facilities/amenities in the Government School, Dhuri was disposed of with a direction to Sub Divisional Magistrate, Dhuri to take a decision on the representation dated 4.10.2013 by passing a speaking order. The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful was not done.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that there is a dispute with regard to property where school is functioning and litigation is pending. She admits that the school is in dilapidated condition. She states that the school was primary and total 26 students were studying and they have been shifted to Government Senior Secondary School for Girls, Dhuri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has verified the fact that 26 students studying in the school in question have been shifted to another school. He states that in spite of shifting, there is a grievance as the students are facing hardship by the said action. He seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law.

The contempt petition stands disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
