The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 01.11.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 24764 of 2017. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

“Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent(s) to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-7) and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief claimed through legal notice, to release the same within a period of next 45 days. The factum of grant of interest shall also be considered in the light of observations made by Full Bench of this Court in case titled as “A.S. Randhawa v. State of Punjab and others, 1997 (3) SCT, 468.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the legal notice has been decided and the retiral benefits has also been released. He further submits that the interest on the amount has also been granted but the details of the calculation of interest has not been given.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Anil Kumar, IEO, office of Director Industries and Commerce, Haryana, states that the details of calculation of the interest would be provided to the petitioner within three weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case, there is any grievance against the calculation of the interest, the petitioner be granted liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
