The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 24.5.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the respondent to refix the pension of the petitioner and release the revised pension with arrears and interest for 38 months from the date of filing of the writ petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record the order dated 17.12.2018 passed by the Government granting sanction as well as order dated 24.1.2019 vide which the relief has been granted to the petitioner subject to the outcome of the writ petition.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, the amount due to the petitioner be deposited forthwith.
