By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner on account of false and frivolous complaint filed against him by respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that initially he had some monetary transactions with Mandeep Singh Chita which had been settled amongst them about an year back but said Mandeep Singh Chita along with Daljeet Singh Sachdeva and Raman Gupta has again submitted some applications to the police pertaining to some monetary dispute. The learned counsel has submitted that although he had moved a representation Annexure P-1 to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation Annexure P-1 expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon in accordance with law at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-1 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful.
