The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 06.11.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25187 of 2017. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Accordingly, instant petition is disposed with a direction to respondents to release all the benefits to the petitioner i.e. gratuity, commuted pension, which have already been sanctioned, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, that too, along-with interest @9% per annum, which shall be calculated after the expiry of three months from the date of retirement of petitioner till its actual realization.

However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.”

Vide order dated 27.05.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner took time to verify the statement made by the learned State counsel that the directions passed by this Court have been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the gratuity and commuted pension have been paid, however, other benefits are still due and he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

No further order is called for in the contempt proceedings.

Disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
