Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, prays for an

The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of
the order dated 21.9.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the
respondent to consider the legal notice dated 7.8.2017 and passed
appropriate orders with the further direction that if the petitioner is
entitled to the payment, the same shall be paid within a period of one
month.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record the order dated 11.4.2018 stated to have been passed in compliance of order dated 21.9.2017. As per the same, the case of the petitioner has been rejected.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

In case the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same order in accordance with law.
