The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 21.07.2017 passed in CWP No. 15826 of 2017:-

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ In the light of the allegations made in the petition, we disposed of this writ petition relegating the petitioner to the B.D.P.O. of the concerned area or the D.D.P.O. Ludhiana who shall look into the petitioner's grievance and take/recommend appropriate action in accordingly with law. ”

Pursuant to the notice of motion, reply was filed stating that the encroachers have been identified and proceedings under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961(for short 'Act') against the illegal occupants of the Panchayat land have been initiated.

In view of reply filed, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. However, he submits that respondents be directed to conclude the proceedings under Section 7 of the Act in a time bound manner.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, there is no doubt that respondents shall ensure that there shall be no unnecessary delay in the disposal of the proceedings under Section 7 of the Act.
