This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 8.9.2017 passed in CWP No. 18844 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulation and instructions issued from time to time and also keeping in view the judgment dated July 13, 2016 passed in CWP No.2312 of 2015, titled as **Alishpa Kumari Vs. State of Punjab and others**, (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court."

Reply by way of affidavit of Krishan Kumar, Executive Engineer, Provincial Division, PWD (B&R), Branch Bhiwani, was filed. Copy has already been handed over to counsel for the petitioner.

As per the reply, the order of this court has been complied with and following benefits have been granted:
