This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 14.9.2017 passed in CWP No. 20922 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"3.Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 26.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same, in accordance with law and the factum of interest on delayed payment be also considered in view of the observations made by Full Bench of this Court in case captioned as "A.S. Randhawa vs. State of Punjab and others, 1997 (3) SCT 468, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioners are entitled to the relief claimed, to release/disburse the same within a period of next 45 days.

4. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved of the order passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.

Learned State counsel submits that compassionate appointment has been given and payment of retiral benefits made. The only issue remains is with regard to release of CPF amount for which the legal heirs of the deceased will have to give succession certificate.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that they have applied for succession certificate and as soon as the same is received, it would be furnished.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that as soon as the needful is done, the amount would be released expeditiously thereafter.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
