This is a revision petition that has been filed seeking to challenge the order of the Rent Controller ordering eviction of the petitioner, which was subsequently reversed by the Appellate Authority with a direction to the petitioner herein to clear all arrears of rent failing which he would be liable to be ejected from the demised shop on the ground of non-payment of rent.

On the asking of the Court whether the arrears of rent had been cleared, counsel for the petitioner herein submits that despite several attempts to contact the petitioner he has not been able to do so.

A perusal of the Court file would reflect that the Civil Revision was filed as far back as 2016 and has been pending consideration since then.

Counsel for the petitioner has sought several opportunities to furnish information regarding whether there has been compliance of the order of the Appellate Authority. Today, he very fairly submits that despite

all efforts taken he has not been able to contact with the petitioner at the given address.

In the above situation, this Court is left with no option except to dismiss the instant revision petition for non-prosecution on failure of the petitioner to satisfy the Court of the order of the Appellate Authority having been complied with. Ordered accordingly.
