Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.103 dated 08.12.2018 under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Khamnon, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2019 in a case under Section 306 IPC, but there is absolutely nothing against the present petitioner.

Learned counsel further contended that Narian Kumar had died on 29.11.2018 and F.I.R. was registered on 08.12.2018 i.e. after receipt of suicidal note. However, in the suicidal note, the petitioner was not named.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh' has affirmed the fact that name of the petitioner does not find

mentioned in the suicidal note, rather the same is against Ritu only and said suicidal note has been sent to Forensic Science Laboratory for comparison and report.

Having considered the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 06.01.2019, name of the petitioner does not find mentioned in the suicidal note, trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be admitted on regular bail on furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
