The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0272 dated 19.06.2018 registered under Sections 379, 406, 448, 506 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana during pendency of the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has raised various arguments that a long period has passed but there is no progress in the investigation and the allegations levelled in the FIR are vague and no cognizable offence is made out.

Heard arguments of learned counsel for the petitioners and have also perused the contents of the FIR and other documents available on the file including FIR.

Admittedly, the investigation is in progress as the FIR was registered on 19.06.2018. To interfere at this stage would amount to interference in the investigation. It cannot be said at this stage as to whether the challan is going to be presented against the petitioner or the cancellation report. Certain pleas of alibi have also been raised, which are matter of investigation. It is premature to say anything till the investigation is completed.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as premature.
