Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.342 dated 24.12.2018 registered under Sections 341/323/354/379-B/149 of IPC at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 14.01.2019, petitioner was granted ad-interim bail by this Court, subject to the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Though the petitioner joined the investigation but since recovery was to be effected from him, vide order dated 26.03.2019, he was again directed to appear before the Investigation Officer and join the investigation.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner as well as for the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janak Raj, states that pursuant to the aforesaid orders, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

Heard.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.01.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
