This order shall dispose of a bunch of contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos. 848, 874, 3368, 3369, 3370, 3371, 3373, 3374, 3471, 3474, 3478, 3479, 3480, 3481, 3482, 3483, 3484, 3571, 3574, 3751, 3752, 4027 and 4028 of 2018 as common question of law and facts are involved therein.

The present contempt petitions have been filed for non-compliance of the order passed by this Court directing the authorities to decide the representation of the petitioner(s) by way of passing a speaking order vide which the respondents sought release of the payment in respect of the bills pending with the department.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents on instructions from the officers i.e. Executive Engineer(s), who are present

the sanction has been received from the Finance Department and the payment shall be released and deposited in the account of the petitioner(s) within four weeks.

In view of the above statement, the present contempt petitions are disposed of with a direction to the respondents to deposit the amount due to the petitioner(s) within four weeks from today.

However, it is made clear that in case the said amount is not deposited within the stipulated period as above, the contempt petitions shall stand revived on an application moved by the respective petitioner(s) and in case the petitioner(s) are forced to do so, a strict view shall be taken on the same.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
