At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the revision petition with liberty to make an appropriate application before the learned Appellate Court for grant of time for making good the deficiency in Court fee.

In view of the petitioner not pressing the revision petition and with a view to permit the controversy between the parties to be settled on merits, the liberty prayed for is granted.
