The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 30.8.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to enquire into the matter himself or get it enquired into by some Gazetted Officer of Police as to under what circumstances the two persons were found to be present there near the police station at late night hours.

Reply has been filed alongwith the enquiry report wherein it is stated that after verifying and enquiring into the matter, it is found that Jang Singh and Lachhman Singh were never picked up by the police officials of Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also pointed out on instructions from the petitioner, who is present in person that the enquiry has been done behind her back and that the said enquiry is contrary to the earlier stand of the respondents that the matter has been compromised.

Further, the respondents never got her statement recorded whereas it is stated in the said report that inspite of call notices sent to the petitioner, she refused to get her statement recorded.

In view of the same, no contempt can be said to be made out.

However, the same is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy of challenging the said enquiry report or any other remedy as available to her under the law.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
