Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for issuance of direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and her family at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 7 and their associates.

Petitioner, who is stated to be the daughter-in-law of respondents no.4 and 5, has submitted a representation dated 08.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana for the relief prayed in this petition.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation dated 08.01.2019 (Annexure P-1) vis-à-vis the prayer made on behalf of the petitioner for protection of the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and her family at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 7 and their associates and to act in accordance with law.
