AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petition bearing CRM-M No.4028 of 2018 filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 was disposed of on 01.02.2018 with the direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide representation dated 18.11.2017 within a period of four weeks from receipt of certified copy of the order.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 29.11.2018 was filed annexing copy of inquiry report dated 01.03.2018 and copy of *kalandra* dated 16.03.2018.

As per inquiry report, the allegations made in the representation were found false and recommendation was made to register *kalandra* under Section 66 of The Punjab Police Act, 2007 against the applicant.

In view of reply filed, there is no cause of action left with the petitioner to pursue the contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the inquiry report and *kalandra*.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
