The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 01.09.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to take a conscious decision by passing of a speaking order on the grievances of the petitioner unfolded in the representation.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the order has been complied with and the speaking order has been passed releasing the principal amount with the further undertaking that the interest amounting to Rs.3,66,941/-on the said delayed payment too shall be paid in installment @ Rs. 1 lac per month.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, the interest amounting to Rs.3,66,941/- be paid to the petitioner within a span of 6 months from today.
