The petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus
for release of Jasleen Kaur, her minor daughter, aged about one and half
years.

The petitioner is the wife of respondent No.4. It is alleged that
her minor daughter was forcibly taken away from her by the private
respondents when she went to the police station to lodge a complaint against
respondent No.4.

During the pendency of the proceedings in this Court, custody
of Jasleen Kaur has been restored to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that visitation
rights may be granted to his client.

The petitioner, who is present in person in Court, has no

objection to that.

The petition is accordingly, disposed with direction that respondent No.4 will be able to meet the minor child on the fourth Sunday of every month at the residence of the petitioner.
