This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 29.2.2016 passed in CWP No. 22624 of 2015 whereby the writ petition was allowed in view of the decision passed in CWP No. 20139 of 2015 titled as "*Chiman Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. and others.*"
