This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1346 dated 09.09.2017 registered under Sections 302/201/34 IPC at Police Station City Jagadhari, District Yamunanagar.

Short reply dated 05.02.2019 by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh IPS, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

After arguing for some time and realizing that this Court is not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner would surrender and move an application for

regular bail and a direction be issued to the court to decide their bail application expeditiously. I find this to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrender before the court on or before 11.02.2019 and move an application for regular bail, it shall be decided expeditiously but in any case by 14.02.2019.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
