Learned counsel for the State on instructions from Mr. Deepak Kumar, Assistant in the office of Director General, Animal Husbandry Department, Haryana states that arrears of re-fixation of pay has been paid, pension would be revised and arrears paid within eight weeks to the petitioner. He further states that details of calculation of amount found due with regard to arrears of pay and pension would be supplied to the petitioner within eight weeks. Mr. Deepak Kumar undertakes that in case the statement made today is not adhered to, he may be burdened with costs which shall be personally recoverable from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.
