This civil revision, under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, was instituted against the order dated 17.10.2017 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram, dismissing the application filed by the petitioner herein, the defendant in CS No. 632 of 2016, under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC.

Mr. Amar Singh, learned counsel representing Mr. Alok Kumar Jain, learned counsel for the petitioner, would inform this Court that in the meanwhile, the plaintiff in the suit reported before the trial Court that he did not wish to proceed further and that the suit may be dismissed as withdrawn.
