This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.60 dated 24.02.2018 registered under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC at Police Station City Narwana, District Jind.

Counsel for the petitioner argues that there is no independent evidence against the petitioner and he has been arrested only on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar states that there is independent evidence against the petitioner. Moreover, as per him all the independent witnesses have been examined and only official witnesses remain to be examined and undertakes that the remaining official witnesses will be examined on or before

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 12.07.2019 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
