Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no benefit has been given to the petitioner in respect of the service, which the deceased-husband of the petitioner had performed with the respondent(s). It has been mentioned that the husband of the petitioner was appointed on 01.09.1986 and he met with an accident while on duty on 21.03.1997. Thereafter, in the year 2014, the husband of the petitioner died, but no benefit has been extended either to the husband of the petitioner during his lifetime or to the petitioner after his death, in respect of the service rendered by the late husband of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondent(s) with a legal notice dated 03.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to respondents to decide the same by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to pass an appropriate order on the legal notice dated 03.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of

certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to her within three months thereafter.
