The grievance of the petitioner is that on three occasions, an enquiry has been conducted by the police and the complaint given by respondent No.5 has been found to be false. Yet, the police is calling him to the police station and is harassing him. A legal notice dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) has also been given but the petitioner has not got any relief.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let 5 copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is necessary to be issued to respondents No. 5 and 6.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the legal notice dated 19.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case founds necessary, within eight weeks.
