This petition has been filed for setting aside of order dated 19.01.2017, passed by the learned District Judge, Chandigarh, whereby the petitioner-tenant was directed to deposit *mesne* profits at the rate of ₹7500/- per mensem from the date of eviction till the final decision of the appeal.
