By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 so as to protect their life and liberty and to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 6.

The learned counsel submits that petitioner No.1 had taken loan from respondents No.4 to 6 and since he was unable to return the entire amount due to some unavoidable reasons, the said private respondents are unnecessarily harassing the petitioners and issuing threats to eliminate them.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana to look into the matter and to decide the representation dated 7.1.2019 Annexure P-1, moved by petitioner No.2 expeditiously preferably within a period of 6 months from today in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. Further in case it is found that there is any imminent

threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 7.1.2019 Annexure P-1 be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna, District Ludhiana so as to enable him to do the needful.
