The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Bhim Singh in case FIR No.157 dated 23.07.2017, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366-A, 216, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal, Haryana.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR. Now, the prosecutrix has also been examined and she has stated nothing against the petitioner.

She has denied if she was abducted by the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 29.07.2018. Trial is in progress. Investigation has already been completed.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars, therefore, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the court.
