At the very outset, counsel for the petitioners states that inadvertently the respondent No.2 has been mentioned as Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala instead of the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar in the array of parties and prays that necessary corrections may be carried out accordingly. Allowed as prayed for.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 & 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age

petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1996 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 07.08.1988. They have also moved a representation before the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-3) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-3).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
