Prayer made in the petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.900 dated 24.10.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, Karnal.

Counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that the complainant/victim-Shivam is present in the Court and the matter stands compromised with him. The case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for counselling and recording the statement of complainant-Shivam.

In his statement, the complainant has stated that a mutual compromise has been effected between the parties and he has no objection if the bail is granted to the petitioner or in case any quashing petition in the case FIR is filed he will make appropriate statement before the Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rishi Parkash, has not disputed the above mentioned fact.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the matter has been compromised, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be release on bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

However, it will be open for the prosecution to apply for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, in case he is found involved in any other case or misusing the concession of bail, in any manner.
