By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 3 so as to take effective steps for protecting his life and liberty as well as of members of his family and also for ensuring that a fair investigation is conducted in FIR No.272 dated 25.11.2018 registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural) for offences under Sections 307, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959.

The learned counsel has submitted that grandfather of the petitioner namely Harnam Singh aged about 88 years is owner in possession of land measuring 73 kanals 1 marla, which was fraudulently got transferred by Hira Singh, who is uncle of the petitioner, vide transfer deed dated 21.9.2018. The grandfather of the petitioner, upon coming to know about the same, moved an application before Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Amritsar under provisions of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, which is still pending. However, Gurdev Singh, son of

petitioner's uncle Hira Singh and Guriqbal Singh @ Babbu, while assuming that the aforesaid application had been filed at the behest of the petitioner, fired shots at the petitioner and his son with an intention to kill them, on account of which FIR No.272 dated 25.11.2018 was lodged.

The learned counsel has submitted that despite the fact that FIR in question was lodged in the month of November 2018, the police has not taken any further steps for conducting any investigation in the same nor has arrested the accused.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab to look into the matter and to decide the representation dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-4), moved by the petitioner expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law and to ensure that the matter pertaining to FIR No.272 dated 25.11.2018 registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural) under Sections 307, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 24 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 is investigated fairly and expeditiously.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 11.12.2018 Annexure P-4 be sent to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, Punjab so as to enable him to do the needful.
