The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0008 dated 7.1.2019 at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The FIR was lodged at the instance of Rana Kanwardeep Kaur, wherein it has been alleged that the petitioner, who is her husband, had opened a joint saving bank account in his name as well as in the name of the complainant by forging her signatures.

Notice of motion had been issued to the State.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the parties have now entered into a compromise.

The aforesaid position is not disputed by Mr. Deepanshu Mehta, Advocate, who is representing the complainant and has also endorsed the factum that the parties have indeed entered into a compromise.

In view of the aforestated position and while also bearing in mind that the petitioner as well as the complainant are husband and wife, to my mind, it is not a case warranting custodial interrogation. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 15.1.2019 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
