GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.92 dated 18.5.2017 under Sections 380, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3, 4 of Punjab Protection of Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention of Violence and Damage to Property) Bill 2008 Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. When this matter was taken up before this Court on 6.2.2019, it was represented by the complainant that there are chances of a compromise. Accordingly the parties were referred to Mediation

and Conciliation Centre of this Court to probe the possibility of the compromise. Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received, as per which the matter has been resolved amongst the parties and as per settlement/agreement dated 28.3.2019, the complainant has accepted the apology tendered by the petitioner/accused and upon an assurance having been given by the petitioner that he will not repeat any such act in future, the complainant has expressed that he has no objection in quashing of the FIR and for acceptance of the petition.

3. In view of the specific settlement/agreement recorded before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and while also bearing in mind the fact that the FIR in respect of the remaining co-accused has also been quashed vide separate order passed by CRM-M-21832-2017, the present petition is accepted and FIR No.92 dated 18.5.2017 under Sections 380, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 3, 4 of Punjab Protection of Medicare Service Institutions (Prevention of Violence and Damage to Property) Bill 2008 Police Station Division No.4, District Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
