ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.106 dated 11.11.2018, under Sections 452, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Maloud, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused had caught hold of the complainant by her arms and legs and is alleged to have given stick blow on the thigh of the complainant. This injury was found to be simple in nature.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 15.01.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/SHO concerned, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurmit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation, the order dated 15.01.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
