The petitioners allegedly agreed to purchase certain plots from the private respondents. The entire sale consideration was paid, but sale deeds were not executed. Thereafter, it was realized that the private respondents were not the owner of the said plots and that a fraud had been committed upon them. A representation dated 5.2.2018 (Annexure P3) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Mr. K.S Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let 04 copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P3) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
