This order shall dispose off first anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. moved by petitioner Bachittar Singh in case bearing Complaint No.41/2016 dated 28.03.2016 titled as 'Sukhwant Kaur vs. Bachitar Singh etc.' under Sections 354, 376, 511, 452, 506 IPC filed before the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)-cum-Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Talwinder Singh, Police Station Chhabal, District Tarn Taran submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 15.01.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

Though vide orders dated 15.01.2019, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail, inadvertently to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer, however, in the light of stand of the State as none from complainant side appeared besides service and thus, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 15.01.2019 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
