The grievance of the petitioner is that although, FIR No.1030 dated 7.10.2018 has been registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, Hisar, under Sections 147, 149, 285, 323, 452 and 506 IPC, the police is not taking appropriate steps thereupon. The accused persons were armed and recovery of live bullet and pistol has been made, yet, Section 307 IPC, has not been added. The eye-witnesses have also got their statements recorded, but on the contrary, a counter FIR has been registered against the petitioner. A detailed representation dated 29.11.2018 (P2) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Mr. S.P Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let 05 copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day. In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek reply, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider representation dated 29.11.2018 (P2) and any other material that may be produced by the petitioner and to take appropriate action,

in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt
