This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 6.8.2018 passed in CWP No. 19322 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 10.05.2017 (P-2) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law and/or to approach this Court."

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Ajoy Sharma, Chief Executive Officer, Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board filed today in Court is taken on record. Copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Along with reply, an order dated 28.8.2019 has been annexed

whereby the claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order passed,no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The petitioner was already granted liberty to have re-course to the remedies in accordance with law by the writ court itself.
