Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-Sukhdev Singh has died during the pendency of this revision petition. However, the matter had been settled amicably between the parties prior to the death of Sukhdev Singh. The factum of settlement is reflected in order dated 28.09.2018 passed by this Court in CR No. 6175 of 2018. Vacant, peaceful possession of the demised premises was handed over to the landlord pursuant to the settlement. It is thus submitted that the present revision petition impugning order dated 06.01.2018 assessing *mesne* profit, has thus been rendered infructuous.
