This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 29.11.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.1-bank, whereby the bank has taken over the possession of the mortgaged property (Shop cum Residential House) belonging to the petitioner under Rule 8(1) of the Security Interest (Enforcement) Rules 2002 with the permission of respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that after filing of the writ petition, the petitioner had approached the bank on 29.12.2018 and has also received a communication from the bank.

3. Accordingly, prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
