AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J.

1. The petitioner has challenged the impugned action of the respondents whereby respondent No.1 has passed the order for taking the possession of the property of the petitioner.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner either to approach the respondent No.3 at the first instance by giving the proposal for discharging the outstanding liability or to take recourse to

the alternative remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
