The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of F.I.R. No.0219 dated 26.08.2018 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC and under Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

On 16.01.2019 the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of F.I.R. No.0219 dated 26.08.2018 registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC and under Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Senior DAG, Punjab, at the asking of the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. Mr. Anil Kumar Spehia, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply two copies of the petition to both the opposite counsel during the course of the day.

To come up on 06.03.2019.

Meanwhile, the parties are directed to be present before the Illaqa Magistrate on 06.02.2019 or any other date convenient to the Court for recording their statements with regard to compromise. The Court is directed to record the statements of both the parties to its satisfaction to know its genuineness that the statements are not the result of any pressure or coercion in any manner. The Court is further directed to send report along with the statements of the parties with regard to validity or otherwise of the compromise effected between the parties and also intimate whether any criminal case is pending against either of the parties or not before the next date of hearing.”

Report of the Sub Division Judicial Magistrate dated 15.02.2019 has been received as per which the complainant appeared and stated that the accused had promised that they would make the payment but they did not make any payment and therefore she is not interested in the compromise.

None has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioners.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
