Through this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0156 dated 27.11.2018 registered under Sections 420/380 IPC at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

According to the prosecution, the petitioner cheated the complainant for ₹ 40,000/- and gold ornaments, on the false pretext of marrying him.

Perusal of order dated 04.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) shows that the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathina, afforded sufficient opportunities to the petitioner to join investigation, but she did not co-operate with the Investigating officer.

Hence, finding no merit in the instant petition, the same is dismissed.
