The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.108 dated 04.11.2018 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 17.09.2019 passed by this Court, on the joint request of learned counsel the parties, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on 17.09.2019 itself.

A report dated 03.10.2019 has been received from the Mediator along with settlement agreement dated 03.10.2019 which is duly signed by the parties.

The factum of compromise between the parties has not been disputed by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

Considering the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide settlement agreement dated 03.10.2019, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.01.2019 passed by this Court, whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is made clear that the parties shall adhere to the terms and conditions of the agreement settlement dated 03.10.2019 in its letter and spirit.
