AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.270 dated 26.10.2017 registered under Sections 353/186/506/341/148/149 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

On 16.1.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the parties have reached an amicable settlement.

Notice of motion for 11.4.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 23.1.2019 at 10:00 A.M. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating

Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Today counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned DAG on instructions from ASI Baljeev Kumar has accepted these factual assertions and stated that they are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 16.1.2019 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
