ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.321, dated 19.07.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 379-B, 386, 427, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although Section 307 IPC has been added in the FIR but the allegations are that a shot was fired in the air but no one was injured in the incident. It is also alleged that a sum of ₹8500/- was snatched from the salesman of the liquor vend. He also contends that FIR is outcome of a rivalry between owners of the liquor vends. The petitioner is in custody for almost a year since his arrest on 31.07.2018. Five co-accused have been granted regular bail by the trial Court while three co-accused have been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-54105-2018, CRM-M-54224-2018 and CRM-M-51568-2018 respectively.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Anand Kumar states that although the challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the co-accused of the petitioner have already been granted regular bail; the petitioner is in custody for almost a year and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
