As per pleadings on record the Gian Sagar Medical College, Banur, was shut down by the State Government in June 2017 and the students pursuing the MBBS Course in such college were shifted to other medical colleges across the State in pursuance to directions issued by this Court in CWP No.7686 of 2017.

Present petitioner who was student of MBBS at the Gian Sagar Medical College, was accordingly shifted to Government Medical College, Faridkot.

The Directorate of Research and Medical Education, Punjab, issued a public notice dated 28.07.2018 to the follwing effect:-

***“DIRECTORATE OF RESEARCH AND MEDICAL

PUBLIC NOTICE***

(Regarding Gian Sagar Medical College)

“This is to inform General Public that Punjab Government has given provisional approval to Gian Sagar Educational and charitable Trust Ramnagar, Banur, District Patiala to start M.B.B.S. And B.D.S. Courses subject to condition that Trust of the Institution will clear all the pending liabilities.

The instant petition has been filed raising a short grievance that even though the petitioner has approached the competent authority under the Directorate of Research and Medical Education Punjab, in pursuance to the public noticed dated 28.07.2018 seeking refund of Rs.15,000/- deposited as security (Library) and Rs.30,000/- as Security Hostel A.C. Room with the Gian Sagar Medical College i.e.total Rs.45,000/- such claim has not been dealt with till date.

Counsel submits that even a rejection order has not been passed.

In view of the above and without going into the merits of the claim set-up, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.1 to examine the matter in the light of the representation dated 10.08.2018 (Annexure P-4) that is already stated to have been submitted.

A final view with regard to the claim of the petitioner be taken in accordance with law expeditiously and in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and the same be communicated to the petitioner.
